- In oral form, by means of a statement issued and recorded in a report by the Head of the Compliance Function.

 In anonymous form, if chosen by the whistleblower, using the designated locked box located in the kitchen of STUDIO TRE SB SPA a Socio Unico. Only the Head of the Compliance Function has the keys to this box and is authorised to view the reports in question.

Each processing operation complies with the procedures indicated in Articles 6 and 32 of the GDPR and adequate minimum security measures will be adopted.

Your data will only be processed by personnel expressly authorised by the Data Controller and in particular by the following categories of authorised persons:

Report manager, i.e. the person(s) tasked with receiving and handling reports, appointed in accordance with Article 4(2) of Italian Legislative Decree no. 24/2023.

Regulation EU 2016/679: Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 - Rights of the Data Subject

- 1. The Data Subject has the right to obtain confirmation of the existence of personal data concerning them even if not already stored, the communication of such data in an intelligible form, and the right to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority.
- 2. The Data Subject has the right to be informed of:
 - a. the origin of the personal data;
 - b. the purposes and methods of the processing;
 - c. the logic applied in the case of processing by electronic instruments;
 - d. the identification details of the data controller, the data processors and the representative designated according to Article 5(2);
